April 2009 will see the fifth annual Canada Milton Seminar (CMS), sponsored by CRRS and funds from the Canada Research Chair program. The aim of the seminar is to provide a focus in the form of an annual meeting for scholars, especially Canadian scholars, working not only on Milton but on early modern literature and culture in general.

Invited speakers include Sharon Achinstein (St. Edmund Hall, Oxford) on “Re-lyricizing Milton” Colin Burrow (All Souls College, Oxford) on “Milton and Imitation” and Elizabeth Sauer (Brock University) on “Linguistic and Cultural Mediation: Milton, Spain, and the New World.”

At the annual general meeting, members will be able to share ideas on how the CMS can continue to develop. Lunch will be served and the gathering will end with a banquet. There will be a registration fee of \$25 / \$10 students. The rates are at par for Canadian and US payments.
